Our event will have 15 Green Zones to dispose of your food scraps and refuse, beverage bottles and then a garbage bin for anything non biodegradable.

All items purchased from Street Vendors are biodegradable including ALL food scraps and ALL serving supplies i.e. paper plates, utensils like souvlaki sticks, forks and cutlery, wax paper, napkins, coffee cups, beer and wine cups can all be tossed into the Organics Bin. Our plan is based on Industrial Grade Composting that will eventually be used back on local Farms!!!

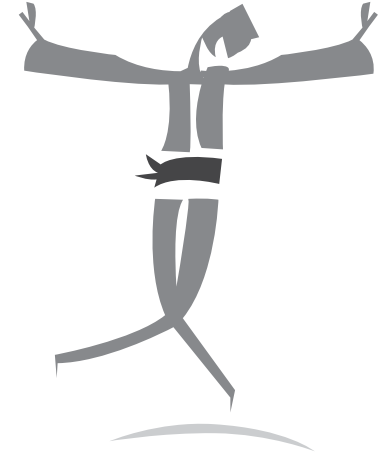
Thank You Smithrite Disposal & Recycling for handling and servicing our sanitation Plan. Thank you Green Century Products for providing earth friendly products.
